1. Jew, citizen of Tarsus in Cilicia, speaking in the Hebrew language. Educated by Gamaliel - Pharisee
2. Persecuted the Way to death, under approval of the high priest. Brought letters towards Damascus to bring those in bonds to Jerusalem to be punished
3. A light shone around him blinding him, calling out to end his persecution of him, clarified to be Jesus of Nazareth. Paul begins to follow Jesus. He was told to go to Damascus to receive his mission. Paul is led to Damascus where Ananias prays for Paul to receive his sight.
4. God appoints Paul to know his will, to see Jesus, to hear his voice, to bear witness to everyone what he saw and heard. Paul is baptized.
5. Paul is commissioned by God to the Gentiles.
