

Jesus is the King of Peace - Matthew 21:1-11, Mark 11:1-10

"Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord; Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!" Mark 11:9b-10 [Hosanna means "Save us" - Psalm 118:25-26]

The peace is for your soul not necessarily your circumstances.

Jesus is Priest King - Matthew 21:12-22, Mark 11:11-26

Our relationship with him empowers us and clarifies our priorities.

Jesus is the Chosen King - Matthew 21:23-27, Mark 11:27-33

We don't decide who the King is, just how we will respond to Him.

How do you respond to him? - Matthew 21:28-32

"But what do you think? A man had two sons, and he came to the first and said, 'Son, go work today in the vineyard.' And he answered, 'I will not'; but afterward he regretted it and went. The man came to the second and said the same thing; and he answered, 'I will, sir'; but he did not go. Which of the two did the will of his father?" Matthew 21:28-30

When Jesus is your King it changes your life.

The Sovereign King - Matthew 21:33-46, Mark 12:1-12

And He began to speak to them in parables: "A man planted a vineyard and put a wall around it, and dug a vat under the wine press and built a tower, and rented it out to vine-growers and went on a journey. At the harvest time he sent a slave to the vine-growers, in order to receive some of the produce of the vineyard from the vine-growers. Mark 12:1-2

A servant of the King understands stewardship.

The Inviting King - Matthew 22:1-14

Go then to where the roads exit the city and invite everyone you find to the banquet.' So those servants went out on the roads and gathered everyone they found, both evil and good. The wedding banquet was filled with guests. Matthew 22:9-10

The invitation is for you. Are you willing to listen and follow?

The Wise King - Matthew 22:15-45, Mark 12:13-37

Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question: "What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He?" They said to Him, "The son of David." He said to them, "Then how does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying,

'The Lord said to my Lord,

"Sit at My right hand,

Until I put Your enemies beneath Your feet""?

If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his son?" No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question. Matthew 22:41-46

Responding to Him - Mark 12:41-44

And He sat down opposite the treasury, and began observing how the people were putting money into the treasury; and many rich people were putting in large sums. A poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which amount to a cent. Calling His disciples to Him, He said to them, "Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the contributors to the treasury; for they all put in out of their surplus, but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned. all she had to live on." Mark 12:41-44

"Sit at My right hand,
