Glorifying God means to:			
1 His greatness.			
2. Give him through praise and worship of Him.			
"I will gather them and bring them to the place that I have chosen, to make my name dwell there." Nehemiah 1:9c			
- remembering what God has done, namely God's faithfulness and goodness.			
- appropriately thanking God for his goodness on our behalf.			
- the necessary response to the character of God, no for what He has done, but who He is. He alone is worthy of being honored and praised.			

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
