

Hi 707 Fall Retreat Parents,

As we gear up for Fall Retreat this weekend, we wanted to touch base with you to give you a few updates!

Covid continues to be a daily reality, and we take that into consideration with all that we do. As with everything we do, we take the safety of our students and staff very seriously. With that said, here is what our plan will entail for Fall Retreat:

- Per Miracle Camp requirements, every student must fill out a health screening form before arriving to camp. This cannot be filled out in advance, it is a digital form that must be submitted on Friday, November 5th.
- Additionally per camp requirements, every student will have their temperature taken before boarding the bus at Oak Pointe. If any student is running a fever (99.6 and above) they will not be allowed to travel to camp.
- Miracle Camp requires masks to be worn in the dining hall until students are seated.
- Masks are encouraged for the remainder of the weekend while indoors, but not required.
- We will have rapid tests on hand for the weekend. If any student begins to show Covid symptoms, we will call home to get permission to administer a test.
 - If they test negative, we will have them wear a mask when around other students for the remainder of the weekend.
 - If they test positive, we will isolate them and contact their parent to pick them up, We will then contact the parents of every other student in their cabin to make a plan for the remainder of the weekend.

It is our hope that we have a safe and healthy weekend away, and will be diligent to take the steps we can to ensure that it is!

I will be sending out separate emails for those that still have any balance due or need to fill out the online Fall Retreat Release form.

Students need to arrive to Oak Pointe Milford a little before 4PM on Friday for check in. The buses will be returning to Oak Pointe Milford at 2:00 PM on Sunday. The buses will not be stopping on the way to/from camp. Dinner will be provided on Friday night once we arrive at Miracle Camp, a snack will be provided on the way home.

Students will need to bring:

- Bible/pen/notebook
- Sleeping bag or sheets/blanket and Pillow
- money for snack shop (optional)
- Warm clothing & shoes
- Shower supplies / Towel
- Flashlight and bag for dirty clothes

Students may **not** bring:

- Cell phones
- Vapes/Juuls
- Anything illegal
