SUMMARY

WHO IS THIS BABY?

"His name will be Jesus" (Role of the Messiah - Savior)

"Son of the Most High" (Reality of the Messiah - Divine)

"The Lord will give him the throne of David" (Relation of the Messiah - Davidic)

In all, the OT contains over 300 prophecies about a future Messiah; and the NT spends its time documenting how Jesus is this Person. Note how Peter sums up their perspective (1 Peter 1:16-21).

MARY'S RESPONSE

Mary's response to God's person and promises was to rejoice in God. She "Worshipped Fully" - she knew what God had said, and she received for herself was God was saying.

If we want to Reclaim Christmas, we too need to Worship Fully! "My soul glorifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my savior." Does ours? Glorifying/Rejoicing in God means that our Hearts are satisfied in God, our Minds regularly rehearse God's promises, our Hands are occupied with carrying out the commands of God. This is a challenge in our culture (idols, entertainment, selfishness). Make Worshipping Fully your Focus right now as Christmas approaches!
