SUMMARY

In the sermon we saw that Jesus is the One who came to recover and bring home people, like you and me, who have gotten lost in the wasteland of our sin. Paul summarized it this way:

- **God is our Heavenly Father** - who created us for relationship with Him.
- **We have all chosen to leave him** - whether actively going our own way, or passively living indifferent to His heart/desires.
- **God makes a way for us to come home** through Jesus going into the far country of our sin, to bring us home to the fair country of his gracious kingdom.

READ...

- **Read Luke 15:1-32** out loud
(if studying in a group, all but one person should keep their Bibles closed for now).
- **Read SLOWLY.** Line by line if you can.
- **Read as if for the first time.**

ASK...

1. **What does this passage tell us about God?**
Tell it plain. Don't be showy, or wordy.
2. **What does this passage tell us about people?**
Picture the scene/people. What stands out?
3. **What else did you learn from this passage?**
What **word** comes to mind after reading?
Why do you think God included this here in the Story?
4. **If you believed this was true, what could be the benefits and how might you apply it to your life?**
What do you want to do as a result of who Jesus is / what Jesus has done?
5. **What about this passage could you share with someone else, and who might that be?**
