SUMMARY

In the sermon we saw that Jesus' religion is not what either Nicodemus nor the woman at the well expected. Jesus surprised them both with **how** he said you draw near to God, and **who** Jesus says can draw near to God. We could summarize it this way:

- HOW we draw near...
 - ...by getting low (humility)
 - ...by being radically remade (experiencing the new birth)
 - ...by worshipping Jesus on His terms
- Who can draw near...
 - ...those who thirst
 - ...those who banter
 - ...those who believe

READ...

- Read John 3:1-7 & John 4:1-26 out loud (if studying in a group, all but one person should keep their Bibles closed for now).
- Read SLOWLY. Line by line if you can.
- Read as if for the first time.

ASK...

1. What does this passage tell us about God?

Tell it plain. Don't be showy, or wordy.

2. What does this passage tell us about people?

Picture the scene/people. What stands out?

3. What else did you learn from this passage?

What **word** comes to mind after reading? Why do you think God included this here in the Story?

4. If you believed this was true, what could be the benefits and how might you apply it to your life?

What do you want to do as a result of who Jesus is / what Jesus has done?

5. What about this passage could you share with someone else, and who might that be?
