

**Matthew 3:16-4:2** As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. <sup>17</sup> And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. <sup>2</sup> After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry.

Mark 6:30-32 The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all they had done and taught. <sup>31</sup> Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, "Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest." <sup>32</sup> So they went away by themselves in a boat to a solitary place.

Mark 6:45-47 Immediately Jesus made his disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd. <sup>46</sup> After leaving them, he went up on a mountainside to pray. <sup>47</sup> Later that night, the boat was in the middle of the lake, and he was alone on land.

Luke 5:15-16 Yet the news about him spread all the more, so that crowds of people came to hear him and to be healed of their sicknesses. <sup>16</sup> But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.

Psalm 46:10 Be still and know that I am God.

**Psalm 62:1** For God alone my soul waits in silence; from him comes my salvation.

**Psalm 131:2** But I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a weaned child with its mother; like a weaned child is my soul within me.

Psalm 139:23-24 Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! <sup>24</sup> And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Part 2 – Slow reading of Scripture

- · Read a portion of Psalm 62 (The Message) 3x slowly (verses 5-8)
- Notice what word or phrase the Lord is highlighting for you.

Part 3 – Reflection with Jesus

- · Jesus, what is something you want me to know about you?
- Jesus, what is something you want me to know about me?
