

The Letter to the Hebrews

Basic Life Group Discussion

This life group discussion guide was created so that a life group can loosely follow along with the 10-week sermon series at Oak Pointe Milford.

Each week the group will be engaged with the chapters of the letter, and then gather to discuss. Below are general questions that can guide the group conversation, and could be helpful to have with you as you read the chapters during the week.

Opening Questions

- What did you like about the chapter this week?
- Was there anything that concerned you about the chapter?
- Was there anything you didn't quite understand about the chapter?

**Note for the leader: Don't feel pressure to resolve any tensions that may arise from someone not understanding a passage. It's ok that you don't know the answer. And it's ok to say "I don't know, but we can ask someone (or figure it out) together."*

Content Questions

- What does this chapter teach us about God?
- What does this chapter teach us about people (us)?
- Is there an example to follow?
- Is there a command to obey or action to take?
- Is there a sin to avoid?
- Is there a promise to claim?

Obedience-Based Questions

- Is there a next step God is asking you to take?
- Who can you share this truth, and next step, with this week?
