KINGDOM QUEST THEME

# Week 1

## LIGHT THE WAY—PREPARING HEARTS & REACHING KIDS

This week's focus: Spiritual readiness, peace, alignment, and community impact as we invite families.

DAY	SCRIPTURE	PRAYER
1	"Again, Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.'" <b>(John 8:12 ESV)</b>	Thank You, Jesus, for who You are. Thank You that I no longer have to walk in darkness, but with You, I walk with the light of life. I ask that You shine brightly through this year's Kids Camp—in our church and our local community. Help me prepare my heart for what You want to do this year through camp.
2	"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." <b>(Psalm 119:105 ESV)</b>	Thank you, God, for the Bible—Your Word. I pray that it will be a guiding light for every decision and moment throughout this year's Kids Camp. I pray like Samuel did, "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening."
3	"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." <b>(Philippians 4:6-7 ESV)</b>	God, I thank You that Your word instructs me not to be anxious about anything. In the lead up to camp, I lay down any anxiety or fear at Your feet, and I give thanks instead for the wonderful work You're going to do. I ask for Your supernatural peace over all the details and tasks coming up, especially in stressful areas like budgeting or scheduling. You are my provider. I trust You.
4	"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." <b>(James 1:5 ESV)</b>	I thank You, Lord, that You said that if anyone lacks wisdom, all we have to do is ask for it. Today, I ask You for Your wisdom in every detail from check-in to check-out. I pray that I would operate not out of a place of stressful decision-making, but that I would have the mind of Christ. Open my eyes and ears to see and hear what You are doing.
5	"Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." <b>(Matthew 11:28-30 ESV)</b>	Jesus, thank You for making things easy when I choose to partner with You! I surrender to You any burdens or expectations I've been carrying on my own, and I rest in the fact that You've got this. I ask that our camp will be filled with Your presence! Help me walk with You in every moment.

DAY	SCRIPTURE	PRAYER
	<p>"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."</p> <p><b>(Matthew 5:14-16 ESV)</b></p>	<p>Thank You, Lord, that You have set us up as Your church to be a light on a hill. I pray that light would not be hidden but that people in our community would see our good works and give You all the glory. I pray that this year's camp would be visible and welcoming to families who are already a part of our church family and those yet to connect.</p>
7	<p>"But Jesus called them to him, saying, 'Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God.'"</p> <p><b>(Luke 18:16 ESV)</b></p>	<p>Jesus, I thank You that You know every child attending our camp by name, even if they have yet to be registered. I ask for wisdom as we use different tools to get the word out, but I also ask that Your Spirit would draw in the children and the families of our community. I pray for divine appointments throughout the coming weeks.</p>

# Week 2

## JOINING THE QUEST—EQUIPPING, PROVISION & POWER

This week's focus: Volunteers, unity, financial breakthrough, supernatural grace, and bold community impact.

DAY	SCRIPTURE	PRAYER
8	<p>"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." <b>(Acts 1:8 ESV)</b></p>	<p>Thank You for Your Holy Spirit, Lord. I pray that You would fill me and my team with boldness and creative ideas to invite our neighbors, classmates, community, and kids to be a part of what You are doing at camp this year. I lay down any hesitation or fear, and I ask that You bring us into perfect alignment with what You desire.</p>
9	<p>"At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ..." <b>(Colossians 4:3 ESV)</b></p>	<p>Lord, I ask today that You would open doors to local schools, community centers, and conversations in our community. I pray that the good news of Jesus would not live within the four walls of our church, but that it would go out! I ask that camp wouldn't just be a summertime event, but that it would have a lasting impact throughout the year.</p>
10	<p>"Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us..." <b>(Ephesians 3:20 ESV)</b></p>	<p>God, I thank You that You are not a father with a limited budget, but that You are the all-powerful God with unlimited resources. I ask God that You would do more than I could ever ask or imagine for this year's camp—spiritually, physically, numerically, and financially. You are our Provider, and we trust You to provide.</p>
11	<p>"As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace." <b>(1 Peter 4:10 ESV)</b></p>	<p>Lord, I thank You that You have given each one of us a gift and that that is irrevocable! I pray that You would stir hearts amongst those in my church community to serve in the areas that we need most for this year's camp. Give me wisdom and discernment to search out those who are not currently using their gifts and ask for their help.</p>
12	<p>"For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another..." <b>(Romans 12:4-8 ESV)</b></p>	<p>What a beautiful thing You are doing in forming this church body, Lord! I thank You that I get to be a part of it. I thank You that I am only one part of it and You have not called me to carry camp on my own. I pray that You would bring volunteers, and that everyone on the team would find their perfect fit and be willing and able to serve with joy!</p>

DAY	SCRIPTURE	PRAYER
13	"Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel." <b>(Philippians 1:27 ESV)</b>	Holy Spirit, I pray that You would bring myself and the team into perfect unity with You, so that we would be in unity with one another. I pray that Your love would cover all interactions and situations throughout camp and that Your grace—the power to transform lives—would flow through everything we do.
14	"The LORD has done great things for us; we are glad." <b>(Psalm 126:3 ESV)</b>	God, I celebrate and thank You in advance for every child who will be reached, every soul that will be stirred, and every life that will be changed through camp this year! You are a good God! You have done and will do great things!
